


Holland Civic Theatre Children & Teen Summer Shows

Tom gets drawn in and soon the teacher is sucked into the television show. We meet a slew of colorful personalities as the entire company tries to comfort him and prepare him for his first day. Featuring all of the familiar faces and the same great songs, such as "Conjunction Junction" "Just a Bill" and "Interplanet Janet", this musical is sure to entertain!

TWELVE ANGRY JURORS—A 19-year-old man has just stood trial for the fatal stabbing of his father. "He doesn't stand a chance," mutters the guard as the 12 jurors are taken into the bleak jury room. It looks like an open-and-shut case—until one of the jurors begins opening the others' eyes to the facts. "This is a remarkable thing about democracy," says the foreign-born juror, "that we are notified by mail to come down to this place—and decide on the guilt or innocence of a person; of a man or woman we have not known before. We have nothing to gain or lose by our verdict. We should not make it a personal thing." But personal it is, with each juror revealing his or her own character as the various testimonies are re-examined, the murder is re-enacted and a new murder threat is born before their eyes! Tempers get



short, arguments grow heated, and the jurors become 12 angry people. The jurors' final verdict and how they reach it—in tense scenes that will electrify you and keep you on the edge of your seat—add up to a fine, mature piece of dramatic literature.
